GENERAL INFORMATION

Summary of 2016 Survey Results

Sugar Glider records were high and stable, with 85% of sites having evidence of Sugar Gliders. This is the same percentage as the 2014 surveys.

Tuan records have increased compared to previous years. This year 45% of sites had evidence of Tuans, compared to 29% in 2014.

(The number of animals seen during the surveys also increased, with 22 Tuans seen inside boxes during the surveys.

Characteristics with Tuans increased across all parts of the Shire, with the North East zone recording a particularly strong increase.

General Boxes in larger (> 50 ha) vegetation patches were more likely to have evidence of Tuans than smaller patches (< 50 ha).</p>

European Bee numbers remained stable and low – only 4% of boxes had active bee hives.
